Abbreviations


k knit p purl

ssk slip 2 stitches knitwise individually, Insert left

needle into the front loops of the slipped stitches and knit them together from this

position through the back loops

k2tog knit 2 together p2tog purl 2 together



Notes

Right and left socks are mirror images of each other and have corresponding charts. Use the appropriate chart for the section (Cable Rib, Cable Pattern, Top of Foot) and sock (Left or Right).

Pattern calls for markers. Markers are not necessary and placements can be marked by needle placements instead.

Cuff - Cable Rib

Cast on 60 [80] stitches. Being careful not to twist, join for working in the round. Work Cable Rib chart.

S [L]

Yarn

100% superwash wool Fingering weight 350-500 yards

Needles

US Size 1.5 / 2.5mm or size needed to obtain gauge

Notions

Cable needle, tapestry needle

Gauge

In stockinette:

8 stitches and 11 rows per inch

In cable rib:

8.5 stitches and 11 rows per inch


In cable pattern:

9 stitches and 11 rows per inch


Sizing Note

For an 8" circumference sock, work size S at 7 stitches per inch or size L at 9 stitches per inch.

Cable Rib - Left Sock 10 stitches



Cable Rib - Right Sock 10 stitches



- knit
- 🗵 knit tbl
- purl
- slip 1 to cable needle and hold to front, k1 from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle
- slip 1 to cable needle and hold to back, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 from cable needle
- slip 1 to cable needle and hold to front, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle
- slip 1 to cable needle and hold to back, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle
