Cable Rib - Left Sock - Multiple of 10 stitches

Row 1: P2, k1 tbl, k2, CRT, p3.

Row 2: P2, k1 tbl, k1, CRK, k1 tbl, p3.

Row 3: P2, k1 tbl, CRK, k1, k1 tbl, p3.

Row 4: P2, CRK, k2, k1 tbl, p3.

Row 5: P2, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p3.

Repeat rows 1-5 twice more.

Cable Rib - Right Sock - Multiple of 10 stitches

Row 1: P2, CLT, k2, k1 tbl, p3.

Row 2: P2, k1 tbl, CLK, k1, k1 tbl, p3.

Row 3: P2, k1 tbl, k1, CLK, k1 tbl, p3.

Row 4: P2, k1 tbl, k2, CLK, p3.

Row 5: P2, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p3.

Repeat rows 1-5 twice more.

Cable abbreviations

CRT Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in back, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle.

CRK Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in back, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 from cable needle.

CLT Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in front, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle.

CLK Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in front, k1 from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle.
