#### **Cable Pattern - Left Sock - Multiple of 20 stitches**

- Row 1: (P2, k1 tbl, k2, CRT, p3) twice.
- Row 2: (P2, k1 tbl, k1, CRK, k1 tbl, p3) twice.
- Row 3: (P2, k1 tbl, CRK, k1, k1 tbl, p3) twice.
- Row 4: (P2, CRK, k2, k1 tbl, p3) twice.
- Row 5: P2, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p4, CRK, k3, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 6: P2, k1 tbl, k2, CRT, p3, CRK, k3, CRT, p3.
- Row 7: P2, k1 tbl, k1, CRK, k1 tbl, p2, CRK, k3, CRK, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 8: P2, k1 tbl, CRK, k1, k1 tbl, p1, CRK, k3, CRK, k1, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 9: P2, CRK, k2, k1 tbl, CRK, k3, CRK, k2, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 10: P2, k1 tbl, (k3, CRK) twice, k3, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 11: P2, k1 tbl, k2, (CRK, k3) twice, CRT, p3.
- Row 12: P2, k1 tbl, k1, (CRK, k3) twice, CRK, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 13: P2, k1 tbl, (CRK, k3) twice, CRK, k1, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 14: P2, (CRK, k3) twice, CRK, k2, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 15: P2, k1 tbl, k3, CRK, k3, CRT, k3, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 16: P2, k1 tbl, k2, CRK, k3, CRP, k1 tbl, k2, CRT, p3.
- Row 17: P2, k1 tbl, k1, CRK, k3, CRP, p1, k1 tbl, k1, CRK, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 18: P2, k1 tbl, CRK, k3, CRP, p2, k1 tbl, CRK, k1, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 19: P2, CRK, k3, CRP, p3, CRK, k2, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 20: P2, k1 tbl, k3, CRP, p4, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p3.
- Rows 21 – 24: Same as Rows 1 – 4.
- Row 25: (P2, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p3) twice.
- Row 26: P2, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p3. Mark new beginning of round.

#### **Cable abbreviations**

- CRT** Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in back, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle.
- CRK** Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in back, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 from cable needle.
- CRP** Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in back, k1 tbl from left needle, p1 from cable needle.

#### **Cable Pattern - Right Sock - Multiple of 20 stitches**

- Row 1: (P2, CLT, k2, k1 tbl, p3) twice.
- Row 2: (P2, k1 tbl, CLK, k1, k1 tbl, p3) twice.
- Row 3: (P2, k1 tbl, k1, CLK, k1 tbl, p3) twice.
- Row 4: (P2, k1 tbl, k2, CLK, p3) twice.
- Row 5: P2, k1 tbl, k3, CLK, p4, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 6: P2, CLT, k3, CLK, p3, CLT, k2, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 7: P2, k1 tbl, CLK, k3, CLK, p2, k1 tbl, CLK, k1, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 8: P2, k1 tbl, k1, CLK, k3, CLK, p1, k1 tbl, k1, CLK, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 9: P2, k1 tbl, k2, CLK, k3, CLK, k1 tbl, k2, CLK, p3.
- Row 10: P2, k1 tbl, (k3, CLK) twice, k3, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 11: P2, CLT, (k3, CLK) twice, k2, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 12: P2, k1 tbl, (CLK, k3) twice, CLK, k1, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 13: P2, k1 tbl, k1, (CLK, k3) twice, CLK, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 14: P2, k1 tbl, k2, (CLK, k3) twice, CLK, p3.
- Row 15: P2, K1 tbl, k3, CLT, k3, CLK, k3, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 16: P2, CLT, k2, k1 tbl, CLP, k3, CLK, k2, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 17: P2, k1 tbl, CLK, k1, k1 tbl, p1, CLP, k3, CLK, k1, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 18: P2, k1 tbl, k1, CLK, k1 tbl, p2, CLP, k3, CLK, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 19: P2, k1 tbl, k2, CLK, p3, CLP, k3, CLK, p3.
- Row 20: P2, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p4, CLP, k3, k1 tbl, p3.
- Row 21 – 24: Same as Rows 1 – 4.
- Row 25: (P2, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p3) twice.
- Row 26: P2, k1 tbl, k3, k1 tbl, p3. Mark new beginning of round.

#### **Cable abbreviations**

- CLT** Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in front, k1 tbl from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle.
- CLK** Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in front, k1 from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle.
- CLP** Slip 1 to cable needle and hold in front, p1 from left needle, k1 tbl from cable needle.
